CROWNWeb In-Person Training To Be Offered!

The Renal Requirements, Communications, and Training (RCT) Team will be conducting in-person CROWNWeb training sessions between October 6-15, 2009 and November 3-12, 2009 at 10 of the largest Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs) in the United States (per the 2008 US Census data estimates). Individuals who will be using CROWNWeb should make plans to attend this in-person training, if possible, to get hands-on experience with navigating through the system.

The in-person training will feature hands-on demonstrations for CROWNWeb users on performing various tasks in the system, and will include exercises that allow attendees to record a patient's entire course of treatment using CROWNWeb. These exercises will range from editing facility details, admitting patients, and running facility-level reports to completing a CMS-2728 Form, entering clinical values, and completing the CMS-2746 Death Notification Form.



Training will be held each day 8am-5pm (local time), with a one hour lunch break.

Attendees will only need to attend one full-day class, as the entire training curriculum will be covered each day.

Registration will be available for each session on August 21, 2009. Seating is limited in most locations to 50 seats per day, so make your plans and get ready to secure your spot today!

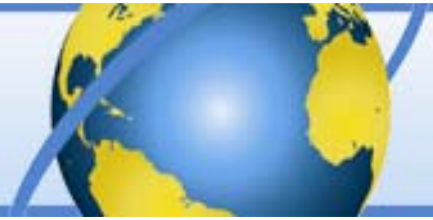
Dr. Crown's FAQ of the Month

Dear Wondering Facility Administrator: If your facility is not participating in the Phase 2 implementation of the CROWNWeb system, you will be able to continue submitting data in the same way you have been doing this. Continuing to submit your data as you have been, even though this may be a manual system, will keep you in compliance.
