Network Contact Utility

As noted in CROWN Memo 10-0490-GN, a new Network Contact Utility is in place to record complaints, grievances, and involuntary discharges. This utility will serve as the interim solution for documentation, trending, tracking and reporting of contacts with patients, facilities, dialysis corporations, state agencies, Networks and others currently captured in the Contacts portion of SIMS until this feature is in CROWNWeb. ESRD Networks can obtain this utility via QualityNet.

Dr. Crown's FAQ of the Month

Dear Dr. Crown: I currently complete and mail copies of the CMS-2728 & CMS-2746 Forms to my ESRD Network. When I'm using CROWNWeb, and I'm no longer required to mail a copy of these forms to my ESRD Network, how will they know when I complete a CMS-2728 or CMS-2746 Form? – CMS Forms Specialist

Dear CMS Forms Specialist: Since CROWNWeb is an electronic, always on, data-collection system, your ESRD Network will be able to access your facility's and patients' data the moment you click the Submit button. Your ESRD Network is able to view the same data on its end as you are able to at your facility and can confirm the submission of your forms.
