CROWNWeb/QIPS WebEx Training!

Were you unable to attend the CROWNWeb hands-on training sessions in January 2009? Do you need a refresher on how to navigate through CROWNWeb? Do you need guidance on how to properly complete and submit your QIPS Account Forms? If you answered 'YES' to any of these questions, then **CROWNWeb/QIPS WebEx Training** is for you! Beginning in March and continuing through the Summer, the CROWNWeb Training Support Team will be hosting weekly WebEx training sessions designed to provide education on maneuvering through CROWNWeb. Each week's sessions will be focused for the facilities in one Network at a time, and the learning sessions will consist of two hours on each of three consecutive days. Each two hour workshop will address how to manage facility and patient data in CROWNWeb, and a new workshop will be presented each day.

Day 1 – Facility Workshop Day 2 – Patient Admit Workshop Day 3 – Patient Treatment Workshop

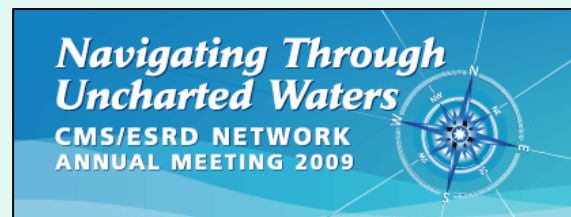

This training is intended to inform potential users of the correct steps to activate their CROWNWeb accounts, and to help all facilities get their QIPS forms submitted and their CROWNWeb access established.

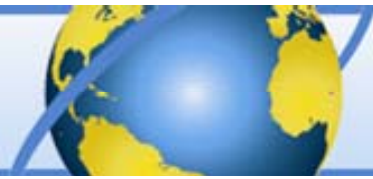
Dr. Crown's FAQ of the Month

Dear Dr. Crown: I manage data for over 50 patients at my facility. With CROWNWeb, will I need to enter their Vascular Access (VA) data every month, even if it's the same? Some of my patients have had the same Access Type for many years. – *Out-numbered Editor*

Dear Out-numbered Editor: No. If the data does not change, you will not need to re-enter your patients' VA data each month. CROWNWeb is designed to carry-over the VA data for a patient from month-to-month. Please note that even with this carry-over, facilities must verify that the VA information is correct and enter patient clinical data, as needed, each month.
