Alpha 0.4 Testing Kicked-off Nov. 24th

The Alpha 0.4 version of CROWNWeb was made available for testing on November 24th, 2008, and will continue until January 2nd, 2009. 254 individuals responded to the call for Alpha 0.4 testers back in October 2008; this group is made up of 117 Network testers, 94 facility testers, and 43 Batch testers. The production Help desk process will also be piloted during Alpha 0.4 testing.

As a “bonus” for participating in the Alpha 0.4 testing, testers who completed their CAS Account Form will be able to explore the final testing stage of CROWNWeb prior to it going live on February 1st, 2009. Alpha 0.4 offers end users new functionality, such as the ability to enter clinical lab and vascular access data. Users can also run a series of audit reports on data changes in the Clinical area of CROWNWeb.

If you were to participate in Alpha 0.4 testing and have not yet received your login information, please contact your Security Administrator (SA) about the status of your CAS Account Form and system access.

Dr. Crown's FAQ of the Month

Dear Dr. Crown: I am a Facility Security Administrator who is interested in granting new Users Roles and Scope in CROWNWeb. I have their completed CAS Account Forms, but forgot when I can begin entering the data in QIPS. Please help! - *Forgetful SA*

Dear Forgetful: Facility Security Administrators will be able to begin adding new Users (not Alpha Users) to QIPS and setting up Roles and Scope in CROWNWeb effective December 8, 2008. Upon entering the data into QIPS, Security Administrator will need to mail the User's original TYPED CAS Account Form, along with the printed PaperWork Info tab from QIPS to the Help Desk.
