QIPS Account Form – ID Expiration Date

How do I correctly complete the QIPS Account Form if I reside in a state that issues non-expiring identification cards?

CMS is currently exploring the best way for account applicants and Security Administrators (SAs) to indicate that the identification provided does not expire. However, it suggests that applicants and SAs do the following until further notice:

Applicants

- Write 12/31/2100 as the expiration date on the QIPS Account Form.

QIPS Security Administrators

- Enter an expiration date of 12/31/2100 when creating the account in the QIPS system.

Dear Facility Data Manager: No. The CROWNWeb system does not replace how you currently manage your patients’ information, test results, treatment data, etc. in-house. CROWNWeb only changes how you submit your facility and patient data to your assigned ESRD Network and CMS. All of your other business processes will remain the same.
