CROWNWeb Authentication System (CAS) Training Scheduled

The CROWNWeb Authentication System (CAS) provides a way for Networks and Facilities to control those who can access CROWNWeb in their organization (Network or facility), as well as the level of access granted to each authorized user.

The CROWNWeb team has scheduled a CAS Training sessions for all Network personnel, as well as individual sessions for the facilities within each Network. These one-hour sessions will feature a short tutorial on the CAS process, and will also provide an opportunity for attendees to submit questions on CAS.

Facility registration instructions for the upcoming CAS Training will be included in the CROWNWeb communication that will be faxed to each facility in early October. See the article below for more details!

2nd CROWNWeb Communication Set to Launch

In early October, Facilities will be receiving an update on CROWNWeb from the CROWNWeb team. This update reiterates the Conditions for Coverage requirements, and provides information on System Requirements, CAS training opportunities, the CROWNWeb Learning Management System (LMS), instructor-led training information and registration, and upcoming critical dates.
